

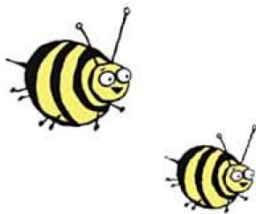

Fisk & Fern also sells tea towels (hand-screenprinted with permanent non-toxic water-based ink, making them save to machine wash cold and dry), as well as 100% cotton aprons with generous pockets and adjustable straps. Fisk & Fern is a little business out of Austin, Texas, operated by illustrator and printmaker Laura Fisk. Fisk always wanted to be a cartoonist.
